Stuart Briscoe is a Christian author, international speaker and the former senior pastor of Elmbrook Church, in Brookfield, Wisconsin. Briscoe is credited with leading Elmbrook from a church of 300 members to one of the largest churches in America. Briscoe was called as senior pastor to Elmbrook in 1970, after a banking career in England and an international, Torchbearers International. He has written more than 40 books and the media ministry, Telling the Truth, which he founded in 1971, continues to reach out daily around the world.

Unleashing Worship

Tom serves as Board Chair of Love INC (In the Name of Christ), a ministry that coordinates the compassion ministries of 20 partner churches in Southwest Lake County. He and his wife Joan live in Lake Barrington and have two daughters - Ashley, a senior at Hope College and Chloe, a freshman at Western Illinois University.

Getting Started in the Christian Life

Based on what God teaches us in Scripture, we'll see how we can live in "the energizing cycle". This is where we become better acquainted with what our spouse needs, and how God wants to work through us to do that.

They've been married for seven years and have two little boys that keep them running. Dave is the Campus Pastor at The Chapel Lake Zurich. He loves seeing the church coming together for things like the No Regrets conference. Dave gets charged up by being outside running, kayaking or anything else that gets him in the woods.

He is also the co-creator of the Endeavor Program and most recently, DirectionNOW: a coaching program to help teens and twenty-somethings align their passions and strengths with their "learning, livelihood and life. He is a graduate of Cornell University and Dallas Theological Seminary.
